START POINT: Pavilion at Lot #1
START TIME: 9:00am – 11:00am
FINISH TIME: Walkers must be off the trail by 3:00pm
DISTANCE: 10K (6.2 miles) or 5K (3.1 miles)

TRAIL: AVA Trail Rating is 2-B. The trail is on paved and grass covered surfaces with minor inclines. It also follows a picturesque footpath along the Wissahickon Creek. One of the highlights is the Hawk Observation Deck where you may witness migrating birds.

REGISTRATION/FEES: Pre-Registration is requested in order to determine amount of food required for the picnic (form on the back of the brochure). IVV Credit is \$3.00. This event is Free for those walkers who wish participate without receiving IVV Credit. There are no refunds.

SPECIAL PROGRAMS: Event qualifies for Bridges Spanning the USA, Treasure Hunt, and PA Counties (Montgomery).

ELIGIBILITY: This event is open to the public. You do not need to be a member of the Liberty Bell Wanderers to participate.

FACILITIES: Parking is free. Water and restrooms are available at the Start/Finish. Restrooms are available along the route. Water should be carried along the route.

CONDITIONS: This event will be held regardless of weather conditions. There are no refunds. No littering. Pets are permitted but must be leashed and picked up after.

DISCLAIMER: The American Volkssport Association or its subsidiary clubs are not responsible for theft or loss of personal belongings or property. All participants must sign a waiver.

PROCEDURES: All participants must register and complete a Start Card which is carried on the walk and must be returned at the Finish. This also applies to free walkers. Start Cards remain the property of the Liberty Bell Wanderers.

DIRECTIONS: (see map on back page)

The Start Point is best reached from Joshua Rd. and not the park's main entrance or the official address which is the park office. Follow the directions below.

From the PA Turnpike I-276, take Exit 339 for Philadelphia/Ambler. Go through the toll booth and past the PA-309 S ramp. Continue straight onto Pennsylvania Ave. Drive 0.7 miles and turn left on Bethlehem Pike. Turn right on Skippack Pike/PA-73 (MaGerks Pub on the corner). After a short distance, go past the main entrance to the park then continue 0.25 miles to the light at Joshua Rd. Turn left on Joshua Rd. Cross Militia Hill Rd., then continue 0.25 miles to State Park Rd. Turn left on State Park Rd., then a quick right at the triangle following signs for Lot #1. Pavilion will be on the left. Also look for LBW road signs which will be posted along the way.

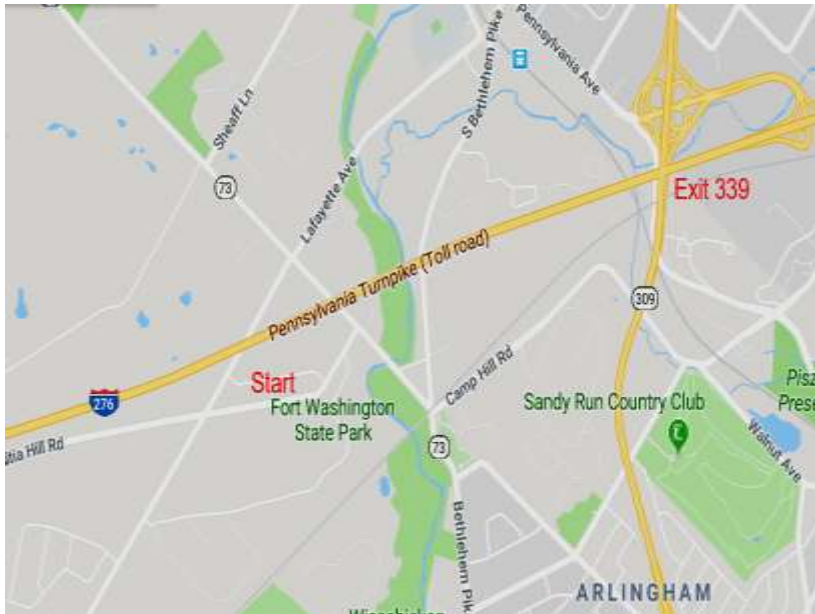
